Subject: Chapter 5.4, carriage of refrigerated liquefied gases

Proposal submitted by the International Union of Railways (UIC)

At its 40th session (Sinaia, 17 – 21 November 2004), the RID Committee of Experts decided by a majority to retain in 5.4.1.2.2 (d) the provision concerning additional information in the consignment note when carrying refrigerated liquefied gases (see also report A 81-03/501.2004, paragraphs 82 to 84).

This provision, which from a safety technology point of view is very important for carriage by rail, only applies at present to tank-wagons and tank-containers and not to portable tanks (IMO tanks in accordance with 1.1.4.3 and UN tanks in accordance with 6.7.4).

For the above reasons, it is proposed to insert ", portable tanks" after "tank-wagons" in 5.4.1.2.2. (d).
