Guidelines for the use of RID/ADR/ADN 5.4.0.2

- The Guidelines for the use of RID/ADR/ADN 5.4.0.2 were adopted at the Joint Meeting (Geneva, 17 to 26 September 2019). See also documents <u>ECE/TRANS/WP.15/AC.1/2019/44</u>, <u>INF.7</u>, <u>INF.46</u> and paragraphs 48 to 51 and Annex III of document <u>ECE/TRANS/WP.15/AC.1/156</u>.
- 2. The Guidelines were then submitted to WP.15 and the RID Committee of Experts. See also informal document <u>INF.17</u> and <u>Add.1</u>, and paragraphs 23 to 24 of the <u>Report of the 107th session of WP.15</u> (Geneva,11-15 November 2019)/document <u>OTIF/RID/CE/GTP/2019/9</u> and paragraphs 86 to 87 of the <u>Final report of the 11th session of the RID Committee of Experts' standing working group</u> (Vienna, 25-28 November 2019). Both these bodies adopted the Guidelines and asked the Secretariats to make them available on the UNECE and OTIF websites.
- 3. In the meantime, the Guidelines have been placed on the <u>OTIF</u> and <u>UNECE</u> websites.
- 4. The Guidelines can be applied on a voluntary basis separately for each transport mode. However, if applied, they must be applied in their entirety.
