**TO THE MEMBER STATES OF OTIF AND TO REGIONAL
ORGANISATIONS THAT HAVE ACCEDED TO COTIF**

Slovakia – withdrawal of the declaration according to Article 42 § 1 of COTIF
(Appendices E, F and G)

United Kingdom – partial withdrawal of the declaration according to Article 42 § 1
of COTIF (Appendices F and G)

1. On 31 January 2007, Slovakia made a declaration that it would not apply Appendices E, F and G. The Member States were notified of this declaration in a circular dated 28 February 2007 (A 56-01/502.2007).
2. In an instrument dated 6 August 2015 delivered to the Secretary General on 27 August 2015, Slovakia fully withdrew this declaration with immediate effect.
3. On 29 June 2006, the United Kingdom made a declaration that it would not apply Appendices E, F and G. The Member States were notified of this declaration in a circular dated 10 July 2006 (A 56-01/507.2006).
4. In an instrument dated 18 August 2015 delivered to the Secretary General on 28 August 2015, the United Kingdom withdrew its declaration concerning the non-application of Appendices F and G with immediate effect.
5. An overview of the state of ratifications, acceptances and approvals of the Vilnius Protocol and its Annex, COTIF 1999, and of the accessions to this Protocol or to COTIF, including the reservations and declarations lodged by the Member States, and the texts thereof, is published on OTIF's website (www.otif.org, under "Publications").
