



On the agenda of WG TECH 39: the priorities defined by the Committee of Technical Experts

The WG TECH working group will hold its 39th session in Brussels on 19 and 20 November 2019.

At the invitation of the European Commission's Directorate-General for Mobility and Transport (DG MOVE), WG TECH has already met at the DG MOVE premises in 2017 and 2018.

The main focus of the working group will be to finalise proposals to amend the Uniform Technical Prescriptions (UTP) Noise, Freight Wagons and Marking of railway vehicles, the vehicle register specifications and the rules for the certification of entities in charge of maintenance.

The group will also examine a draft amendment to the Committee of Technical Experts' Rules of Procedure. This draft amendment to the Rules of Procedure proposes a new calendar of meetings so as to give the European Commission the time it needs to analyse legislative proposals that are put to a vote and, consequently, to facilitate the decision-making process within the European Union.
