134th Session of OTIF's Administrative Committee

OTIF's Administrative Committee will hold its 134th session on 19 and 20 May 2021 as a remote meeting.

This will be the last session in the 2018-2021 term of office for members of the Committee designated by the 13th General Assembly. The 13th General Assembly also elected Poland to chair the Committee.

The members of the Administrative Committee for the period from 1 October 2018 to 30 September 2021 are:

In accordance with Article 15 § 3 of COTIF 1999, the composition of the Committee was changed. From the 132nd session, North Macedonia, Pakistan's deputy on the Committee, sat in place of Pakistan.

In this 2018-2021 term of office, the Committee will have held five regular sessions physically in Berne or remotely, owing to the COVID-19 pandemic. 130th session, 28 February 2019; 131st session, 25 and 26 June 2019; 132nd session, 4 and 5 December 2019; 133rd session, 3 and 4 November 2020; 134th session, 19 and 20 May 2021.

At this 5th and last session in this cycle, the Administrative Committee will in particular examine the 2020 activity report and financial management report and will look at progress on the project to renovate OTIF's headquarters. It will also finalise its own activity report, which will be submitted to the 15th General Assembly.
