At present (March 2012) the ten following EU OTIF Member States have withdrawn their declarations according to Article 42 of the Convention not to apply the APTU and ATMF Appednices: Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Finland, Greece, Hungary, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Netherlands and Poland. These States have therefore become Contracting States to COTIF 1999. With regard to implementation of the NVR, they are subject to Commission Decisions 2007/756/EC and 2011/107/EU. The same applies to Norway and Liechtenstein, which also comply with these EU regulations.

According to information from ERA, the following information was given at the meeting of RISC on 24 and 25 November 2011 (RISC = Railway Interoperability and Safety Committee - the EU's decision-making organ, which is equivalent to OTIF's Committee of Technical Experts):

- 1. Implementiation of the NVR has been delayed.
- 2. The proposed implementation timetable for the new EC VVR system is as follows:
 - New VVR software (version 1.2) was available to MS on 31 January 2012,
 - Testing of new software started on 1 February 2012,
 - Production environment will start (after 7 months of testing) on 1 August 2012 with 2 weeks transition period after which the present 1.1 production environment will go down,
 - Once new Release 1.2 is in production, MS will make final check of the data consistency across all registers, to be completed by the end of 2012.

The EC VVR connection status "Test" or "Production" (referring to version 1.1) is following (as of 16 March 2012):

- 15 EU OTIF MS have online status: Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Denmark, France, Italy, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Sweden, Slovak Republic, Slovenia and Spain. Norway, which complies with these EU regulations, also has online status,
- 5 EU OTIF MS have offline status: Austria, Belgium, Estonia, Greece and Ireland
- 5 EU OTIF MS are not involved neither in testing or production: Germany, Finland, Hungary, Latvia and United Kingdom. Communication to overcome these issues has already started with some of them.

Three non-EU OTIF MS plan to connect to the EC VVR in the near future: Montenegro, Serbia (both based on the sNVR) and Switzerland (NVR-TE²).
