Sessions of the WG Tech are held in English only. There will be no interpretation. This is in accordance with Article 23 § 1 of the Rules of Procedure of the CTE of 13 June 2023 and the decision taken by the CTE at its 3rd session (Bern, 11-12 February 2009).

Before applying for a Swiss entry visa, delegates should be designated by their government to attend the OTIF meeting and inform the OTIF Secretariat accordingly. They must ensure they have all necessary supporting documents before visiting the nearest Swiss Embassy or Consulate to obtain the visa.

Travel to Bern

Delegates are advised to travel to Bern by train. There are frequent and convenient connections directly from the international airports of Geneva and Zurich. Tickets can be purchased online (https://www.sbb.ch/en/) or via the SBB App on mobile devices at any time before departure, or at the train station.

Reaching the meeting venue and other logistics

The meeting venue is most easily reached by public transport, using urban train S7 from Bern railway station. The stop is Papiermühle, which is the second stop after Bern. The connection is covered by the public transport ticket (zones 100, 101) that is usually issued to guests who stay in a hotel in Bern.



Reaching the meeting venue

Train S7 departs 8 times per hour from Bern main station platform 23 or 24 (you can take any S7 train in the direction of Worb Dorf or Bolligen). It takes 7 minutes to reach Papiermühle station.

The meeting venue is within 5 minutes' walking distance of Papiermühle station. Upon disembarking the train at Papiermühle station, walk in the opposite direction of travel without crossing the tracks (refer to the red arrow in the picture below). The building of the Federal Office of Transport (Bundesamt für Verkehr - BAV) is the first building on the right, at the end of the street.
