Located in a central, international neighbourhood, OTIF enjoys a prime location, within easy reach of public transport (tram: lines 7 and 8; bus: line 12) and Berne Central Station (five tram stops away).

The Organisation's recently renovated building is suitable for hosting international conferences and meetings, corporate events and workshops, etc.

Equipped with the latest technology, its conference room features ready-to-use interpreting facilities, and its Vilnius meeting room offers an elegant and modern setting for all your meetings, whether hybrid or in-person.

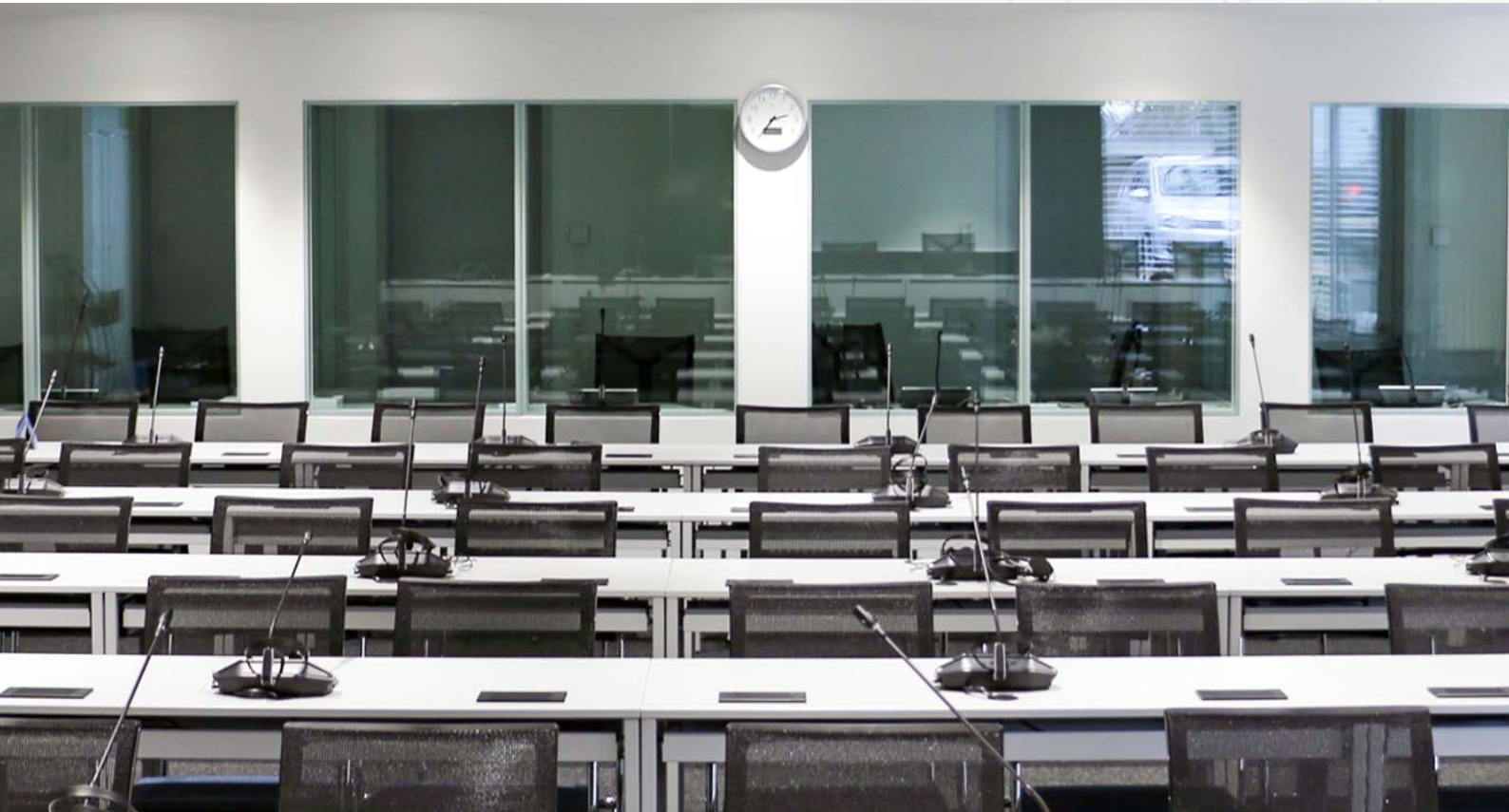
