

## **Multilateral Special Agreement RID 4/2011**

according to section 1.5.1 of RID  
concerning transitional provisions for in-house inspection services (IS)

- (1) By derogation from the provisions of 1.8.7.1.4 of RID, manufacturers having applied to establish an in-house inspection service according to 1.8.7.1.4 of RID and holding on the 30<sup>th</sup> June 2011 a valid certificate for supervising the manufacture of transportable pressure receptacles according to Module D or F or are certified as a Module-2 body according to 6.2.1.4.4 of the provisions of RID as listed in 1.6.2.7 and as applicable until the 31<sup>st</sup> December 2008, may continue to use these certificates until the end of the period of validity, but at the latest until 31<sup>st</sup> December 2011.
- (2) Manufacturers may carry out the supervision of manufacture and issue documentation for the products concerned according to the certificates mentioned above. In such cases, monitoring of the applicant by the relevant inspection body (audit) may be carried out according to the procedures established for this purpose.
- (3) The manufacturer shall ensure that a copy of this multilateral special agreement RID 4/2011 is attached to the documentation for the products concerned and shall keep a further copy with his records.
- (4) The other applicable requirements of RID must be fulfilled.
- (5) This agreement shall be valid until 31 December 2011 for the manufacture of pressure receptacles on the territories of those RID Member States signatory to this agreement. If it is revoked before then by one of the signatories, it shall remain valid until the above mentioned date only for the manufacture of pressure receptacles on the territories of those RID Member States signatory to this agreement which have not revoked it.
