## Multilateral Special Agreement RID 7/2012

under section 1.5.1 RID concerning IBC packing instructions IBC 04 to IBC 08 under sub-section 4.1.4.2 RID

- (1) By derogation from the provisions in RID column 8 of Table A in Chapter 3.2 in relation to RID 4.1.4.2, the following intermediate bulk containers (IBCs) may be used in addition to the IBCs referred to:
  - (a) in the framework of packing instruction IBC 04, IBC types 31A, 31B and 31N;
  - (b) in the framework of packing instruction IBC 05, IBC types 31A, 31B, 31N, 31H1, 31H2 and 31HZ1;
  - (b) in the framework of packing instructions IBC 06, IBC 07 and IBC 08, IBC types 31A, 31B, 31N, 31H1, 31H2 and 31HZ1.
- (2) This agreement shall be valid until 31 December 2014 for carriage on the territories of the RID Contracting States signatory to this Agreement. If it is revoked before that date by one of the signatories, it shall remain valid until the above mentioned date only for carriage on the territories of those RID Contracting States signatory to this Agreement which have not revoked it.
