Depositary notification

Monaco – Approval of the modifications to COTIF and Appendices E and G adopted by the 13th General Assembly



In his capacity as the Depositary, the Secretary General of the Intergovernmental Organisation for International Carriage by Rail (OTIF) notifies you of the following information:

On 23 June 2026, the Principality of Monaco deposited its instrument of accession to the modifications to COTIF (including the adoption of Appendix H (EST)) and to Appendices E (CUI) and G (ATMF) adopted by the 13th General Assembly.

This instrument was not accompanied by any declarations.

The Principality of Monaco is the fifteenth OTIF Member State to approve the above modifications.

In accordance with Article 34 § 2 of COTIF, the modifications to the Convention adopted by the 13th General Assembly will only enter into force twelve months after they have been approved by two thirds of the Member States in accordance with their national law, i.e. at present once 32 Member States have approved them.

In accordance with Article 34 § 3 of COTIF, the modifications to Appendix E (CUI) adopted by the 13th General Assembly will also only enter into force twelve months after they have been approved, in accordance with their national law, by half the States that have not made a declaration in accordance with the first sentence of Article 42 § 1 of COTIF, i.e. at present once 21 Member States have approved them.

In accordance with Article 34 § 3 of COTIF, the modifications to Appendix G (ATMF) adopted by the 13th General Assembly will also only enter into force twelve months after they have been approved, in accordance with their national law, by half the States that have not made a declaration in accordance with the first sentence of Article 42 § 1 of COTIF, i.e. at present once 22 Member States have approved them.
